Edward Pittston This Indenture made this 21st day of November in the year of our Lord 1831 between
 Littleton R. Edward of the first part, Samuel Kello of the second part, and Robert Goodwin,
 the third part, Samuel Kello of the second part, and Robert Goodwin of the third part
 Whereas the said Samuel Kello on the 25th day of October in the year of our Lord
 1830, in order to secure the payment of the sum of Two Hundred and fifty two dollars
 and 25^{cts} to the said Robert Goodwin did by indenture of trust of that date convey
 to the said Littleton R. Edward his heirs etc ff the following property trust: on half
 of the Mill and lands attached to it known as Brightons formerly (and unchristened)
 by Robt. G. Simmons and the said Samuel Kello, also a tract or parcel of land adjoining
 the said Mill Pond containing One Hundred and thirty acres more or less also
 tract or parcel of land adjoining the lands of Titus Darden and Peter Price, situated
 between the road leading to Smithfield and Belhaven and the mill Pond before men-
 tioned containing One hundred acres more or less, also one other tract or parcel of land ad-
 jacing in the County of Hertford in the State of North Carolina adjoining the land of Titus
 Darden, John Britte, the lands on which he at present resides and Clement Rochelle
 and a part of the land formerly belonging to Mrs. Daugtry etc? containing two hundred
 acres more or less, likewise three beds and furniture two Bureau half a dozen chairs
 ff. chairs & c. upm't trust for the uses and purposes in the said indenture mentioned and
 whereas since the executing and delivering of the said deed of trust, the said Samuel
 has paid through the hand of Clements Rochelle, the sum of one hundred dollars
 in part of the sum of money thirty seven, which the said Robert Goodwin did fully
 acknowledge. & now this Indenture witnesseth that for the consideration aforesaid
 as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Samuel Kello
 to the said Littleton R. Edward at and before the executing and delivering of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Littleton R. Edward with the seal
 and approbation of the said Robert Goodwin signified by his being a party to the same
 and the said Robert Goodwin have granted bargained and released and by these presents
 do grant and release unto the said Samuel Kello the right and title which the said
 Littleton R. Edward and Robert Goodwin have or have in the tract or parcels of land lying
 in the State of North Carolina and County of Hertford (this tract here described only)
 adjoining the land of Titus Darden John Britte (the land on which at present resides)
 and Clements Rochelle and a part of the land belonging to Mrs. Daugtry etc. contain-
 ing two hundred acres more or less. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
 to the said Samuel Kello his heirs and assigns forever and the said Littleton R. Edward and
 Robert Goodwin for themselves their heirs &c the above mentioned Land unto the said Samuel
 Kello do warrant against the claims of them the said Littleton R. Edward and the
 Goodwin and all persons by or unto whom or either or either of them by
 virtue of whom of the parties to these presents have heretofore or
