 Littleton R. Edward of the first part, Samuel Kello of the second part, and Robert Goodwin of the third part,
 Whereas the said Samuel Kello on the 2nd day of October in the year of our Lord 1830 in order to secure the payment of the sum of Ten Hundred and twenty five dollars
 and 25 cts to the said Robert Goodwin, did by indenture of trust of that date convey
 to the said Littleton R. Edward his heirs and assigns the following property to wit: one half
 of the Mill and lands attached to it, known as Brightens formerly (and purchased from
 by Robt. G. Simmons and the said Samuel Kello, also a tract or parcel of land adjoin-
 ing the said Mill Pond containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less and
 tract or parcel of land adjoining the lands of Chas. Webb and Peter Pierce, situated
 between the road leading to Smithfield and Bethel and the mill Pond before men-
 tioned containing one hundred acres more or less, also one other tract or parcel of land ly-
 ing in the County of Hartford in the State of North Carolina adjoining the land of Peter
 Darden, John White, the land on which he at present resides, and Clements Rockwell
 and a part of the land formerly belonging to Mills Daughtry &c. containing two hundred
 acres more or less, likewise three beds and furniture two Bureaus half a dozen chairs &c.
 &c. &c. upon trust for the uses and purposes in the said indenture mentioned and
 whereas since the executing and delivering of the said deed of trust, the said Samuel Kello
 hath paid through the hands of Clements Rockwell the sum of one hundred dollars
 in part of the sum of money thereby secured, which the said Robert Goodwin doth hereby
 acknowledge: & for that Indenture Wm. Updegraff testifies that for the consideration aforesaid
 as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Samuel Kello
 to the said Littleton R. Edward at and before the executing and delivering of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Littleton R. Edward with the assent
 and approbation of the said Robert Goodwin signified by his being a party to these presents
 and the said Robert Goodwin have granted, conveyed and released and by these presents
 do grant and release unto the said Samuel Kello the right and title which the said
 Littleton R. Edward and Robert Goodwin have or hold in the tract or parcel of land lying
 in the State of North Carolina and County of Hartford (this tract here described only)
 adjoining the lands of Peter Darden John White (the land on which at present resides)
 and Clements Rockwell and a part of the land belonging to Mills Daughtry &c. contain-
 ing two hundred acres more or less, To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
 to the said Samuel Kello his heirs and assigns forever and the said Littleton R. Edward and
 Robert Goodwin for themselves their heirs &c. the same mentioned land unto the said Samuel
 Kello do warrant against the claims of them the said Littleton R. Edward and Robert
 Goodwin and all persons by or under them or either of them
