To Eighteen Hundred and thirty one. Between Lewis Broom of the first part William W. Cutler
Whitfield the Trustee of the second part and Benjamin Whitfield of the third part all of the County of
Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas the said Lewis Broom stands jointly indebted
to the said Benjamin Whitfield by home bearing even date with these presents in the
sum of Twenty Dollars which debt with the legal interest thereon owing the said
Lewis Broom is willing and desirous to sume & pay this Indenture Witnesseth
that for and in Consideration of the sum of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the
said Lewis Broom in hand paid by the said William W. Cutler & the Trustee at and
before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
edged for the said Lewis Broom hath given granted bargained sold aliened conveyed
released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien convey
release and confirm to the said William W. Cutler his heirs and assigns forever the
following personal property to wit. A cow head of hog and their increase together with
all the right title and interest of the said Lewis Broom in the above mentioned
personal property hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted. To have and to
hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted property as above
mentioned unto the said William W. Cutler the Trustee his heirs Executors and
assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said William W. Cutler
his heirs Executors and assigns forever and the said Lewis Broom for himself his
heirs Executors and assigns doth hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said
William W. Cutler his heirs Executors and assigns forever that the aforesaid per-
sonal property hereby conveyed unto the said William W. Cutler his heirs Executors
and assigns against all persons who at or without shall and will remain and forever defend
by these presents. Upon trust nevertheless that the said William W. Cutler
his heirs Executors and assigns shall permit the said Lewis Broom to remain in quiet &
peaceable possession of the said personal property hereby conveyed until default
be made in the payment of the said sum of Twenty Dollars either in the whole
or in part and then upon this further trust that the said William W. Cutler
or his heirs Executors and assigns shall and will so soon after the happening of such
default of payment as he or they may think proper or the said Benjamin Whitfield
his heirs Executors and assigns shall request sell all the aforesaid personal property
hereby conveyed or such part thereof as the said Trustee or his representatives hereunto
authorized to act shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think proper after
having fixed the time and place of sale at their own discretion and give at least ten
days previous public notice of the time and place of said sale by advertisement posted
