that for and in Consideration of the sum of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the
said Lewis Broome in hand paid by the said William M Cutler the Trustee and
before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledg'd
by the said Lewis Broome hath given granted bargained sold alway's enforfeite
released and Confirme and by these presents doth give grant bargains sell alway's enforfeite
release and Confirm to the said William M Cutler his heirs and assigns forever the
following personal property to wit One Head of Hogs and their increase together with
all the right title and interest of the said Lewis Broome unto the above mentioned
personal property hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted To have and to
hold the said Forely granted or intended to be hereby granted property as above
mentioned unto the said William M Cutler the Trustee his heirs Executors and
assigns forever to the only proper use and behoef of the said William M Cutler
his heirs Executors adms & assigns forever and the said Lewis Broome for himself his
heirs Executors adms doth hereby Commande promise and ag w to and with the said
William M Cutler his heirs Executors adms and assigns forever that the aforesaid per-
sonal property hereby Conveyed unto the said William M Cutler his heirs Executors
and assigns against all persons what ever shall and will occur and for ever defend
by these presents Upon true & swch left that the said William M Cutler
his heirs Executors & adms shall permit the said Lewis Broome to remain in quiet &
peaceable possession of the said personal property hereby Conveyed until default
be made in the payment of the said sum of fourteen dollars either in the whole
or in part and thereupon the Trustee shall that the said William M Cutler
or his heirs adms or assigns shall and will so soon after the happening of such
default of payment as he or they may think proper or the said Benj Whitfield
his heirs Executors or assigns shall request sell all the aforesaid personal property
hereby Conveyed or such part thereof as the said trustee or his representative herein
authorized to act shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think proper after
having fixed the time and place of sale at their own discretion and give at least ten
days previous public notice of the time and place of such sale by advertisement, paid
