

This 21<sup>d</sup> Entered and recorded on this 8<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of  
 Anno Domini 1831. by David BellMatthews of the first part and Benoit R Whitefield of  
 (both) the second part and Williams W Miller, of the third part all of the County of Shenandoah  
 and State of Virginia & Thomas the said David BellMatthews stands, partly indented to  
 the said William W Miller by Bond bearing over due with these presents on the  
 sum of Thirty two dollars and Eighty cents which debt with the legal interest thereon  
 according the said David BellMatthews is willing to pay to secure a writing  
 Indenture whereof shall for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar  
 of lawful money of Virginia to the said David BellMatthews in hand paid by the  
 said Benoit R Whitefield the Trustee at and before the sealing and delivery of  
 these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said David B  
 BellMatthews hath given granted Bargained Sold aliened unfeoffed released and Com-  
 firmed and by these presents doth give grant Bargain Sell aliened unfeoffed release and  
 Confirm to the said Benoit R Whitefield his heirs and assigns forever the following  
 personal property to wit two feather Beds and furniture one blue painted chest one  
 pine chest six sitting chairs two narrow axes three red Kois, one Gun, two ploughs  
 horses one dogone plough one ploughshare cast and ploughing gear one dutch oven  
 one frying pan one Skillet six open Heated Plates Case Trivies and forks one  
 set of other makers tools one looking glass one pot table one painted safe ten Boxes  
 of good Corn two breeding does and their increase two starks of blade fodder together  
 with all the right title and interest of the said David B BellMatthews in and to  
 the above named personal property hereby Conveyed or intended to be hereby granted  
 To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted but  
 as above mentioned unto the said Benoit R Whitefield the Trustee his heirs Executors  
 administrators and assigns forever to the only proper use and service of the said Benoit R White-  
 field his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said David B  
 BellMatthews for himself his heirs Executors doth hereby Convey and promise and  
 agrees to and with the said Benoit R Whitefield his heirs Executors and assigns  
 forever that the aforesaid personal property hereby conveyed unto the said Benoit  
 R Whitefield his heirs Executors and assigns forever against all persons whatsoever  
 shall and will remain and forever defend by these presents upon trust aforesaid that  
 the said Benoit R Whitefield his Executors shall permit the said David BellMatthews  
 to remain quiet and peaceable possession of the said property hereby Conveyed until  
 default be made in the payment of the said sum of Thirty two dollars and Eighty Cents aforesaid  
 in the whole or in part and then upon this further trust, that the said Benoit R White-  
 field his heirs Executors and assigns shall and will so soon after the happening of such  
 default of payment as he or they may think proper or the said William W Miller  
 his heirs Executors and assigns shall request, sell all the aforesaid personal property being  
 Conveyed or such part thereof as the said Trustee or his representative hereby authorized to  
 act I shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think proper still to the highest  
 bidder for ready money at public auction after having fixed the time and place of  
 sale at their own discretion and give at least ten days previous public notice  
 of the time and place of such sale by advertisements posted up at three or more public  
 places in the neighborhood and out of the monies arising from such sale shall after deferring  
 the charges thereof, and all other expenses attending the execution of these presents pay to
