

Nathans *Indenture made and entered into on this 8th day of October in the Year of*
our Lord 1834 Between David B. Nathans of the first part and Berniet & Whitfield of
the second part and William M. Fuller of the third part all of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia Whereas the said David B. Nathans stands indebted to
the said William M. Fuller by Bond bearing even date with these presents in the
sum of Thirty two dollars and Eighty Cents which debt with the legal interest thereon
according to the said David B. Nathans is willing & desirous to secure & satisfy
Indenture Whenceforth that for and in Consideration of the sum of One dollar
of lawful money of Virginia to the said David B. Nathans in hand paid by the
said Berniet & Whitfield the Trustee at and before the sealing and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to the said David B.
Nathans hath given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and Con-
firmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release and
Confirm to the said Berniet & Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever the following
personal property to wit two feather Beds and furniture one blue painted chest one
pinus chest six sitting chairs two narrow axes three wood hews one Gout hoe two ploughs
hows one dozen plough one ploughs hoe Cart and ploughing gear one dutch oven
one frying pan one skillet six open headed Barrels Case Tomes and Forks one
set of shoe makers tools one looking glass one penknife one painted safe ten pounds
of good Corn two breeding sows and their increase two stacks of blades of corn together
with all the right title and interest of the said David B. Nathans in and to
the above named personal property hereby conveyed or intended to be hereby granted
To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted
as above mentioned unto the said Berniet & Whitfield the Trustee his heirs and assigns
adms and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Berniet & Whit-
field his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said David B.
Nathans for himself his heirs Executors and assigns doth hereby covenant promise and
agree to and with the said Berniet & Whitfield his heirs Executors adms and assigns
for ever that the aforesaid personal property hereby conveyed unto the said Berniet
& Whitfield his heirs Executors adms and assigns forever against all persons whatsoever
shall and will be quiet and forever defend by these presents upon Trust to wit to wit that
the said Berniet & Whitfield his Executors adms shall permit the said David Nathans
to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said property hereby conveyed until
default be made in the payment of the said sum of Thirty two dollars and Eighty Cents
in the whole or in part and then upon this further trust that the said Berniet & Whit-
field his heirs Executors adms or assigns shall and will so soon after the happening of said
default of payment as he or they may think proper or the said William M. Fuller
his heirs Executors or assigns shall request sell all the aforesaid personal property hereby
conveyed or such part thereof as the said Trustee or his representative hereby authorized to
act shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think proper to sell to the highest
bids for ready money at public auction after having fixed the time and place of
sale at their own discretion and give at least ten days previous public notice
of the time and place of such sale by advertisements posted up at three or more public
places in the neighborhood and out of the moneys arising from such sale shall after satisfying
the charges thereof and all other expenses attending the execution of these presents pay to
