To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land together with the negro slaves and other property herein before mentioned unto him the said Richard Morris as Trustee aforesaid whom first and upon this express condition that is to say should the said John Nomack neglect or refuse to pay any of the debt or debt or sum of money for which the said Henry Moore is bound as security for the said John Nomack that then and in that event it shall be lawful and is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents for the said Richard Morris as Trustee aforesaid who is hereby required at the request of the said John Nomack or Henry Moore or either of their representatives or whomever it may be required by the Trustee to sell the aforesaid tract or parcel of land subject to the trust herein aforesaid together with the negro slaves and other property herein mentioned, that should the said Henry Moore suffer or be likely to suffer this it shall be lawful at any time by giving twenty days legal notice to sell the above named tract or so much thereof as to pay and satisfy my debt or debt interest and costs that the said Henry Moore is liable to and the said John Nomack do hereby command and defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract of land the negro slaves and other property unto him the said Richard Morris as Trustee aforesaid. Between William Holt of the first part Hanif Holloman of the second part and Benjamin L Drew of the third part All of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said William Holt for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars which said bearing date the first day of June One thousand eight hundred and thirty one as well as all other monies which may hereafter be owing from the said William Holt to the said Benjamin L Drew by means of any dealing Transfer of debts paid whatever, which may take place hereafter, as also for and in consideration of one dollar to him in Guards paid by the said Hanif Holloman the receipt whereof the said William Holt doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted bargained and sold these presents with his grant long and well known and make over unto the said Hanif Holloman and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property to wit One negro man by the name of a Nicks belonging to him the said William Holt, To have and to hold with all the right and interest of the said Nicks Holt herein contained or intended to be conveyed to him the said Hanif Holloman his heirs and assigns
