This Indenture made and entered into this 1st day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and thirty one: Between William Holt of the first part Hannaford Holleman of the second part and Benjamin L Draw of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said William Holt for and in consideration of the sum of sixty dollars which said Bany L Draw sum is due from the said William Holt to the said Benjamin L Draw by him bearing date the first day of June One thousand Eight Hundred and thirty one as well as all other moneys which may be due and owing from the said William Holt to the said Benjamin L Draw by means of any dealing transfer of debt or paper whatever, which may take place hereafter, as also for and in consideration of one dollar to him and him paid by the said Hannaford Holleman the receipt whereof the said William Holt doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said Hannaford Holleman and his heirs forever, all his right and interest in the following property to wit, One negro man by the name of a Nick belonging to him the said William Holt, To Have and to Hold with all the right and interest of the said William Holt herein conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him the said Hannaford Holleman and his heirs
