 to Lewis Womwell date with these presents in the sum of Two hundred dollars which debt with the
 legal interest thereon according the said John Story is willing and desirous to secure
 and discharge this Indenture, witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises
 and also for the further Consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the
 said John Story in hand paid by the said R. P. Barnes trustee at and before
 the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged, by the said John Story hath given granted bargained sold alured infofta
 released and Confirmed by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alire
 infofta release and Confirm to the said Robert P. Barnes Trustee his heirs and assigns
 found the following property to wit One certain tract or parcel of land situate
 lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke's
 Containing by late Survey fifty two acres be the same more or less it being
 the said Story's share in right of his wife of the land of Jordan Dick dec'd
