 Norrell tell of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas
 Examined and that the said John Story is justly indebted unto the said Lewis W. Orr
 Norrell by his bearing to Lewis W. Orr Norrell debt with these presents in the sum of Two hundred dollars which debt with the
 by John Story legal interest thereon accruing the said John Story is willing and desirous to secure
 March 1832 For this Indenture, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promises
 and also for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the
 said John Story in hand paid by the said Rob^t P. James Trustee at and before
 the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged by the said John Story hath given granted bargain'd sold aliened in full
 release and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain'd sell alien
 in full release and confirm to the said Robert P. James Trustee his heirs and assigns
 forever the following property to wit, One certain tract or parcel of land situate
 lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke's
 containing by late Survey fifty two and 3/4 acres be the same more or less it being
 the said Story's share in right of his wife of the land of Jordan Wick dec^d
 and bounded by the land of said Lewis W. Orr Norrell Lewis Wick and others
 also stand ere two calves and their increase, twelve sheep, one dog and five increase,
 seven fat hogs, three feathered h'd steers and furnished eleven hot and brooks one
 Spider, one skillet, one meal stand, one tray one dunn round printer plates one printer
 dish ten printer spoons, one printer basin, two tin basons, one quart pot, one pint pot
 one half pint pot, seven head of sheep and increase, seven quarts cotton and
 three plough hook, two castles, one Sack Dragon one muck dragon, one grubbing bar
 three roading hoes, one iron wedge one hand saw, one drawing knife one spin
 wheel, two pair card one pin chest, one safe one Corn &c. also one pair of
 cut wheels twelve cut plank, two shafts two & 3/4 stacks blade fider scythe
