Saints Mrs Indenture made this 22nd day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirty
two between James Jenkins of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first
part James Lott a man of Color of the second part and Sam Brown Trotter of the third part
Ex-^d of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia (H. W. Nichols) that the said James
Jenkins having become greatly indebted to the said James Lott in his written obligations
fully release from under the hand and seal of him the said James Jenkins as follows. One Bond for fifty
dollars due December 25th 1831. one other Bond for the same due December 25th 1832. one Bond
for the same due Decr 25th 1833 on Bond for the same due December 25th 1834 one debt for the
same due December 25th 1835 and one Bond for the same due December 25th 1836 which the said
James Jenkins is willing and desirous to have now that he desires further obliga-
tions, that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said
Sam Brown Trotter as aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James
Jenkins with, long and well and by these presents doth bargain sell also Convey and Confirm
unto the said Sam Brown Trotter as aforesaid the following tract of land lying and being in
the County of State aforesaid One tract containing by estimation four and a half acres and bounded as follows
by the lands of John Clark, Guy Jenkins and Miles Glade also one other tract containing forty seven
acres and bounded by the lands of the said John Clark Miles Glade and Jimmy Lee, also one other tract
containing Seventy seven and a half acres and bounded by the said John Clark James Jenkins Guy
Jenkins and Miles Glade To have and to hold the aforesaid tracts or parcels of land together
with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging so in any way appertaining unto me the said
James Jenkins unto him the said Sam Brown Trotter his heirs and assigns and upon the
express condition that if the above named Bonds shall not be discharged on or before the 25th day of Decem-
ber 1836 at which time the last payment becomes due, then in that case the said Sam Brown Trotter upon his
said his heirs executors administrators and assigns shall after giving fifteen days written notice to the said day at
the request of the said James Lott his heirs executors administrators and assigns sell to the highest bidder at some con-
venient place for cash Virginia money, the aforesaid tract of land and out of the monies arising from
such sale first pay off and discharge all reasonable and true charges attending such sale and then
discharge all the aforesaid Bonds which may not have been paid off with interest and costs which
may lawfully have accrued thereon and I the said James Jenkins do for myself my heirs executors
administrators and assigns warrant and forever defend the said tract or parcel of land against the
right title claim and entitl of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. H. W. Nichols
