This Indenture made the twenty Eighth day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty between John Carroll and Rhoda his wife of the County of Henry of the one part, and Jesse Carroll, of Southampton of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Carroll and Rhoda his wife in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth, to them in hand paid by Jesse Carroll at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold, conveyed, transferred, quitclaimed and delivered unto the said Jesse Carroll his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows, by the lands of Benjamin Carroll, Erson Grand James Pitts Thomas Gray and the land of Nicholas P. Parham formerly Peter Booth's and containing one hundred and forty acres be the same more or less, together with all and the several and several remainders and remainders of any and other rents issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with the Tenements, Hereditaments and all and singular other the premises heretofore mentioned or intended to be conveyed and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members appurtenances unto the said Jesse Carroll his heirs and assigns forever.
