

Rogership This Indenture made and entered into on the day of October in the year of our Lord one
 thousand Eight Hundred and thirty one: Between Robert A Rogers Lucy P Rogers his wife
 formerly Lucy P Whitfield and Wm M Cutler Trustee to a Deed in Trust executed to him by
 the said Robert A Rogers and Lucy his wife for certain purposes therein mentioned, bearing
 date on the 18th of ^{April} 1831 and duly Recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County all of the
 said County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part; and Bernad K Whitfield of
 the same County and State of the other part, All Witnesseth that the said Robert A Rogers and
 Lucy P his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of seventy six dollars and twenty five
 cents Current money of ~~that~~ ^{the} said County and State of the one part, have granted bargained sold aliened on fee simple and Confirmed, and by these presents do and each
 of them doth grant bargain sell alien on fee simple and Confirm unto the said Bernad K Whitfield
 his heirs and assigns forever all their right title interest claim or demand which they
 now have or ever may or might have in and to a certain tract or parcel of land and premises
 situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's Con-
 taining three hundred and sixty eight acres more or less which said tract or parcel of land
 and premises, the said Whitfield the father of the said Lucy P Rogers, and formerly devised and be-
 queathed by his last will and Testament to Eymour Whitfield as well appears by reference being
 made to said will and Testament which was duly Recorded in the Clerk's Office in the aforesaid
 County of Southampton the said tract or parcel of land and premises bounded by the lands of
 many others, William M Cutler Lewis Monroe and others To Have and to Hold all the
 right title and interest claim or demand of them the said Robert A Rogers and Lucy P Rogers
 his wife which they now have or ever may or might hereafter have, by virtue of the aforesaid will
 and Testament of in and to the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with all and
 singular its appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto him the said Bernad
 K Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said
 Bernad K Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever and the said Robert A Rogers and Lucy P Rogers
 his wife for themselves their heirs and administrators do and each of them doth hereby Covenant
 and agree to and with the said Bernad K Whitfield his heirs and assigns that the
 right title interest claim or demand of in and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises
 hereby conveyed, or intended to be hereby conveyed they will by these presents warrant and defend
 against the Claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever (and the said
 Wm M Cutler Trustee for himself his heirs and assigns doth hereby relinquish unto him the said
 Bernad K Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever all the right and title to the aforesaid
 tract or parcel of Land and premises that was asserted in him by virtue of the Deed in Trust
 mentioned in the former part of this Deed In Witness whereof the said Robert A
 Rogers Lucy P Rogers and William M Cutler have hereunto set their hands and affixed
