This Indenture made this 15th day of October in the year of our Lord Christ 1831 Between Martha Broadhurst of the first part, Patrick Dole of the second part and Benjamin Griffen of the third part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Martha Broadhurst is greatly indebted unto the said Benj^m Griffen on the sum of Thirty four dollars fifty two cents due by Bond bearing date with these presents, which the said Martha Broadhurst is willing and desirous to have on the said Indenture discharged; that for and in consideration of the promised and also for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to her in hand paid by the said Patrick Dole at or before the ensaing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; She the said Martha Broadhurst hath given, granted and sold and by these presents do give and bargain and sell unto the said Patrick Dole as his heirs executors & administrators forever the following property; One bay horse four years old, one feather bed and furniture, two carts and wheels and ten bushels of corn of the crop growing; with all and singular the rights and titles and to the before mentioned property to have and to hold to the only person now and hereafter of him the said Patrick Dole his heirs executors & administrators notwithstanding the said Patrick Dole his heirs executors & administrators shall permit the said Martha Broadhurst to remain in quiet possession of the above named property until default be made in the payment of the above sum of Thirty four dollars fifty two cents either in whole or in part and then upon this further trust, that the said Patrick Dole or his legal representative, shall and will do soon after the happening of such default of payment, as he may think proper or the said Benjamin Griffen his heirs & executors request, sell to the highest bidder for ready money, the above named property or so much thereof pay the debt as above and interest; and all costs attending this instrument after making the same at as many public places as he may think proper, giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale, and pay to the said Benjamin Griffen his heirs & executors interest due and all costs attending the same and then pay the overplus of any to the said Martha Broadhurst her heirs & executors. But the whole of the before mentioned sum of money and the interest and costs be fully paid off so that no default of payment be made then this Indenture to be void, else remain in full force and virtue for ever.
