This Indenture made this 1st day of December in the year of our Lord 1831. Between Benjamin E. Blunt and Sarah his wife of the County of Smithampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John Whitehead of the same County and State of the other part. All those to wit that the said Benjamin E. Blunt and Sarah his wife in consideration of twenty five dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth, to them in hand paid by the said John Whitehead at or before the making of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said John Whitehead his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying or being in the County and State aforesaid, and containing by estimation Seven hundred acres &c. the same more or less and bounded as follows by the lands of James Jackson &c. Smith Richard &c. Volant, Nathan Pope and William Francis To have and to hold the said bargain and sold or parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging in any wise appertaining unto the said Benjⁿ E. Blunt and Sarah his wife their heirs and assigns forever, unto him the said John Whitehead his heirs &c. and assigns and also the said Benjamin E. Blunt and Sarah his wife for ourselves their heirs &c. and assigns, mean and forever defend the said tract or parcel of land against the right title claim and interest of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. In Witnes whereof also the said Benjⁿ E. Blunt and Sarah his wife have hereunto set our hand and affixed our seals this day and year first above written
