His Indenture made this 30th day of June Anno domini 1831 between Jesse Clenton and Elizabeth
 his wife of the County of Lincoln and State of Tennessee of the one part, and Barham Warrum of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said
 Jesse Clenton and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty dollars to
 them in hand paid by the said Barham Warrum the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained and sold and hereby do hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said
 Barham Warrum his heirs or assigns forever all their interest in a certain tract or parcel of land
 lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing one hundred &
 sixty four acres and a half it being the Plantation whereon Mary Pitts died and of which she
 did at present reside as lying and being on the north side of Raccoon Swamp and bounded
 by the Land of George Blount Joseph Brown the land belonging to the Estate of John Pitts
 dec^d the Raccoon Swamp and Barham Warrum the land intended to be sold being that
 which the said Jesse Clenton and Elizabeth his wife purchased from Edmund Pitts dec^d
 which the said Jesse Clenton and Elizabeth his wife have and do hereby sell as aforesaid unto the said Barham Warrum his heirs or assigns
 forever with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging and the aforesaid
 Jesse Clenton and Elizabeth his wife, do hereby Covenant with the said Barham Warrum
 that they have good power and lawful Authority to grant bargain and sell the same hereby cov-
 enanting and forever defending the legal title of the interest they have may or can have or in and
 to the said parcel of land to the said Barham Warrum his heirs and assigns forever. In Witness
