his wife of the County of Lincoln and State of Tennessee of the one part, and Bartham W. Ormon of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said
Jeph Clanton and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty dollars to
them in hand paid by the said Bartham W. Ormon the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
have granted bargained and sold and hereby doth grant bargain and sell unto the aforesaid
Bartham W. Ormon his heirs or assigns forever all their interest in a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing One hundred &
forty four acres and a half situateing the Plantation wherein Mary R. Pitts widow of Wm Pitts
dec^d at present resides lying and being on the north side of River on Tramp and bounded
by the Land of George Blot Joseph Morris the land belonging to the Estate of John Pitts
dec^d the Raccoon Tramp and Bartham W. Ormon the land intended to be sold being that
which the said Jeph Clanton and Elizabeth his wife owned from Edwin Pitts dec^d
which they have and do hereby sell as aforesaid unto the said Bartham W. Ormon his heirs aforesaid
forever, with all and singularly the appurtenances therunto belonging and the aforesaid
Jeph Clanton and Elizabeth his wife, do hereby covenant with the said Bartham W. Ormon
that they have good power and lawfull authority to grant bargain and sell the same hereby con-
tracting and for ever defending the legal title of the interest they have may or can have of or in
to the said tract of land to the said Bartham W. Ormon his heirs and assigns forever. Witness
