Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum and few sum of Five thousand dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the said Commonwealth for the payment thereof well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our joint and several hands Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 22nd day of November 1831.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above Constable James Nick was lawfully appointed by the County Court of Southampton to serve as Constable over the said County of Southampton in the Lower district of a Tithing Parish, that said Court 1830, now if the said James Nick shall well and truly discharge the duties of the Office of Constable in the said County during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be held and to remain in full force and effect.
