Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the first and full sum of Five thousand dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the said Commonwealth for the payment whereof we and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our joint and several heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 22^d day of November 1831.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said James Wick has been duly appointed by the County Court of Southampton to serve as Constable in the said County of Southampton in the Lower district of Newmar Parish two hundred and fifty dollars of the said James Wick shall receive and truly discharge the duties of the Office of Constable in the said County during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be paid or else to remain in full force and Virtue

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Elias Summrell was on the 17th day of October 1831 by the School Commissioners in and for the County of Southampton appointed them Treasurer for the year ending the 31st day of December 1832 a sum of the said Elias Summrell shall faithfully apply and account for all monies which may come to his hands by virtue of his Office, and shall do perform and execute all and every act and thing appertaining to his said Office according to Law then the above obligation to be paid or else to remain in full force and Virtue
