This Indenture made the 4th day of October 1831 Between Richard Booth and Elizabeth his
wife of the County of Surry and State of Virginia of the one part, and W^m. Holt of the County of
Southampton and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Richard Booth
and Elizabeth his wife in consideration of Four Hundred and fifty dollars of lawful money of
this Commonwealth, to them in hand paid by the said William Holt, it or before the entering
and delivery of these presents, he receipt to himself is hereby acknowledged have bargained and
sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said W^m. Holt
his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land in the County of Southampton Contain-
ing by estimation One Hundred and twenty acres of land more or less and bounded on the North
East by the lands of Edmund Bailey dec^d On the South by the lands of Joseph Hart, dec^d and on
West by the lands of Mary Hollamans together with all and singular the appurtenances
if and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders yearly and other rents
issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To Have and to hold the
said tract of land with the tenements hereditaments, and all and singular other the
premises with the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold
and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurten-
ances unto the said W^m. Holt his heirs and assigns forever And the said Richard
Booth and Elizabeth his wife for themselves and their heirs the said land with all
and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said
William Holt, his heirs and assigns freed from the claim or claims of them the
said Richard Booth and Elizabeth his wife or either of them their or either of their
heirs And of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall need and do loan and
and for ever defend by these presents, In Witness whereof the said Richard Booth
