Witnesseth that the said Lewis Ferguson and Margaret his wife for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty Dollars current money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Sarah Ferguson at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Which granted bargained and sold along with profits and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell along with profits and confirm unto him the said Sarah Ferguson his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land Situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton On the South side of Ashley River and in Parish of Saint Luke's Containing by estimation Twenty two and a half acres be the same more or less and bounded follows to wit on the South by Lewis Allmon's land on the West by Thomas Blum's land formerly Jacob Bailey on the North by Wm. M. M. M. and Jacobus Stuy and on the East by Charles Daughtry formerly Robert Daughtry it being the land formerly belonging to Sarah Ferguson dec'd. together with all right title interest claim or demand of and to the said tract or parcel of land and premises with all appurtenances thereto belonging and any verse appertaining To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances unto the said Sarah Ferguson his heirs and assigns forever and for the only proper use and behoof of the said Sarah Ferguson his heirs and assigns and the said Lewis Ferguson and Margaret his wife for themselves their heirs Executors administrators and assigns and hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Sarah Ferguson his heirs and assigns that they will warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land hereby conveyed against the claim or demand of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
