Livsey vs. Griffin This Indenture was made this 29th day of November 1831 Between John Livsey and Henry Griffin of the County of Northampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Samuel S. Griffin of the County of Southampton of the other part: Witness that the said John Livsey and Henry Griffin for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and forty Dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Samuel S. Griffin before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Livsey and Henry Griffin do hereby acknowledge, hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel S. Griffin his heirs and assigns forever one tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton State of Virginia containing four hundred and eleven acres of the same or less adjoining of the land of John Brown on the East bounded by the lands of Samuel S. Griffin and Joshua Griffin on the North and bounded on the South of John Verghulst, on the North West, it being the tract of land which said S. S. Griffin did buy and purchase of and was sold at public auction by John H. C. Thompson his Clerk to the said John Livsey To have and to hold the said tract of land unto the said Samuel S. Griffin his heirs or assigns forever And the said John Livsey and Henry Griffin do hereby covenant and assign do hereby the eighth title or claim warrant and forever defend and secure against the lawful claim of all and every person or persons who shall or may hereafter claim the said John Livsey and Henry Griffin have set their hands and affixed their seals this day and date above written signed sealed and delivered
