Byrken of the County of Southampton of the other part: Witnesseth that the said John Livsey and Henry Livsey for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and forty dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Samuel S. Byrken before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Livsey and Henry Livsey do hereby acknowledge, hath given granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel S. Byrken his heirs and assigns forever one tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton State of Virginia containing four hundred and eleven acres of late Samuel S. Byrken or less adjoining of the land of John Brown on the E. and bounded by the lands of Samuel S. Byrken and Joshua Byrson on the North and bounded on the South of John Byrson, on the North West, it being the tract of land which David S. Byrson dec'd devised and bequeathed of and was sold at public auction by John H. C. Chapman his ex^r to the said John Livsey To have and to hold the said tract of land unto the said Samuel S. Byrken his heirs or assigns forever. And the said John Livsey and Henry Livsey doth embleen their heirs or assigns with by these presents the right title or claim want and forever defend and secure against the lawful claim of all and every person or persons who may or may not hereafter claim the said John Livsey and Henry Livsey do hereby acknowledge that they have and do hereby acknowledge their day and date above written signed sealed and delivered
