This Indenture made and entered into this 16th day of December in the year of our Lord
 1831 Between Mary Grattney of the County of Southampton and State of Oregon of the one part
 and Henry Jones of the same County and state of the other part witnesseth that the said Mary
 Grattney for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars Current Money of the
 State of Oregon, remitted to her in hand paid by the said Henry Jones at or before the inscating and
 the 19th day of December of this present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained
 and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
 enfeoff and confirm unto the said Henry Jones his heirs and assigns forever one ac
 tive tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton
 and Parish of St. Lukes Containing by late Survey twenty two acres be the same more
 less of being the land wherein John Heath now resides and bounded as follows to w^e begin
 ning at a dead pine at corner for Joshua Thompson Lewis Allen's line thence along said
 Thompson's line N 46 E 114 poles to a red pine a corner in said Thompson's line a new
 line S 12 E 17 poles to a new corner in William Allen's line thence along said Allen's line
 S 70 W 55 P to a corner near the road for Lewis Allen's line along his line to the beginning
 again Together with all right title interest claim or demand of in and to the said tract
 or parcel of land and promises, vestiges appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise
 pertaining To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and promises
 with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Henry Jones his
 heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose and intent of him the said
 Henry Jones his heirs and assigns forever for rent. And the said Mary Grattney
 for herself her heirs Executors and administrators hereby covenant and agree and wish
 the said Henry Jones his heirs Executors and assigns that she will by these presents
 warrant and for ever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and
 promises and every part and parcel thereof against the claim or demands of all and every
