Know all men by these presents that Mary Galtrey of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Henry Jones of the same County and State of the other part. Well to wit that the said Mary Galtrey for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars Current money of the State of Virginia to her in hand paid by the said Henry Jones at a before the writing and the 19th day of delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, conveyed and sold, do hereby grant, convey and confirm unto the said Henry Jones his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of lands, situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke's Containing by late survey exactly two acres be the same more or less it being the land, to have in John Leath's new record and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Dead point a Corner to Joshua Thompson's Land lies thence along said Thompson's line at 46. E 114th poles to a Dead point a Corner in said ^{Traverse} ~~Traverse~~ line thence a true line at 12. E 17th poles to a new Corner in William Allen's line thence along said Allen's line at 70. W 50th poles to a Corner near the road for Lewis Allen's line thence along his line to the beginning Together with all rights title interest claim or demand of or in and to the said tract or parcel of land and promises, covenants appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and promises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Henry Jones his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Henry Jones his heirs and assigns forever forever And the said Mary Galtrey for herself her heirs Executors and assigns doth hereby covenant and agree and with the said Henry Jones his heirs Executors assigns and assigns that she will by these presents warrant, defend and support the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and promises and every part and parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons who shall or will claim the said Mary Galtrey hath hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal this day and year first above written
