This Indenture made this 5th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two Between Thomas Lawrence of the first part, Dr. or Gardner of the second part and W^m E. Lawrence of the third part, all of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia Whereas the said Dr. or Gardner on the 24th day of July 1830 in or on to himself the payment of the sum of Fifty two dollars to the said William E. Lawrence did by indenture of trust of that date, convey to the said Thomas Lawrence his heirs &c. and assigns the following property to wit all that tract or parcel of land wherein the said Dr. or Gardner held adjoining the land of Cornelia Gardner, Sife Gardner and others containing one hundred acres more or less; also all his stock of horses Cattle and hogs, farming utensils of every kind and all of the household and kitchen furniture of every description upon trust for the uses and purposes in the said indenture mentioned and whereas since the making and delivering of the said Deed of trust, the said Dr. or Gardner hath fully satisfied and paid to the said William E. Lawrence the sum of money thereby secured and said the said William E. Lawrence doth hereby acknowledge that the said Indenture is in full discharge of the consideration therein expressed as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Dr. or Gardner to the said Thomas Lawrence at and before the making and delivering of the said presents, the receipt whereof he doth acknowledge he the said Thomas Lawrence recith the assent and approbation of the said William E. Lawrence signified by his being a party to these presents, and the said William E. Lawrence has granted bargain and sold released and confirmed unto these presents do grant bargain and sell remise release and confirm unto the said Dr. or Gardner all the Estate right title interest claim and demand, both at Law and in equity which the said Thomas Lawrence and W^m E. Lawrence have or hold in the said and other property above described To Have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and other property to the said Dr. or Gardner his heirs &c. and assigns forever but the said Thomas Lawrence and William E. Lawrence for themselves their heirs &c. and assigns the above mentioned land and other property unto the said Dr. or Gardner his heirs &c. and assigns in as full and ample a manner as the same can be warranted by the said Dr. or Gardner by the Deed of trust above recited, do warrant the same to the said Dr. or Gardner against the claim or claims of them the said Thomas Lawrence and William E.
