This Indenture made this 27th day of December year 1831. Between Henry Blown & Elizabeth Blown wife of the one part, and William S. Blow of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry Blown and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty five pounds & six pence to them in hand paid by the said William S. Blow at or before the enrolling as & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted bargained sold and confirmed and do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said William S. Blow two certain pieces or parcels of land containing by list survey three acres and two acres and bounded by the following named persons land to wit one of said tracts by the land of Amos Stephenson, Thomas Ridley, James Blow, Barnet Edwards and Fisher Fick the other tract by the land of James Blow, Richard Wick, the heirs of John Rochelle de & Williams Fick and James Rochelle the whole thereof being a part of the tract of land which Richard Blow did seized and possessed and which by his last will he by devise bequeathed unto the said Henry Blown Robert Blow and Samuel Blow lying and being in the County of Southampton near the Cypress Bridge. To have and to hold the said pieces or parcels of land together with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said William S. Blow his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Blown and Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs and assigns forever and agrees to warrant defend give or parcel of land to him the said William S. Blow and his heirs against the claim or claims of all persons whatsoever.
