This Indenture made this 27th day of December year 1831. Between Henry Blom and Elizabeth Blom his wife of the one part, and William T. Blom of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry Blom and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty new Penns. Dollars to them in hand paid by the said William T. Blom at or before the enrolling as. & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted bargained sold and confirmed and do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said William T. Blom two certain pieces or parcels of land containing by late survey three Penns. and 7/10 acres and bounded by the following named persons land to wit. One of said tracts by the land of Amos Stephenson, Thomas Ridley, James Blom, Barnet Edwards and Fisher Fick the other tract by the land of James Blom, Richard Fick, the heirs of John Rochelle dec'd Williams Fick and James Rochelle the whole thereof being a part of the tract of land which Richard Blom did seized and possessed and which by his last will he by devise to James Blom Henry Blom Robert Blom and Samuel Blom lying and being in the County of Southampton near the Cypress Bridge. To have and to hold the said pieces or parcels of land together with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said William T. Blom his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Blom and Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs and assigns covenants and agrees to warrant defend peace or parcel of land to him the said William T. Blom and his heirs against the claims or claims of all persons whatsoever.
