Said Indenture made and entered, into this 31st day of December 1831, in presence of
 William T. Blom of the first part, Littleton R. Edwards, of the second part, and Henry Henry,
 the third part, Witnesses that whereas the said William T. Blom, being duly sworn, testified
 unto the said Henry Henry the following facts to wit: One thousand and no hundred
 dollars and five hundred and on the 25th December 1833, were interest from the said tract
 of land amount is due. Now the said William T. Blom being desirous to indemnify and discharge
 him the said Henry Henry the payment thereof, but more especially for the sum of one
 dollar as to him in hand paid by him the said Littleton R. Edwards before the ending and
 delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged that the said
 William T. Blom hath granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant
 bargain and sell to him the said Littleton R. Edwards, his heirs and assigns forever
 Two Tracts or parcels of land containing by late survey three hundred and seventy four
 acres lying and being in the County of Southampton and in the district of Saint Paul's
 Parish One of the said tracts bounded as follows to wit, by the land of Amos Thompson
 Thomas R. Hay James Blom Bernette Edwards and Archer Dick the other tract by the land
 of James Blom Richard Vick the heirs of John Rochelle, do^{rs} William Dick and James
 No Child the whole thereof being a part of the tract of land which Richard Henry
 devised and purposed and which by his last will he bequeathed to James Blom Henry
 Blom Robert Blom and Samuel Blom To have and to hold with all their rights and
 privileges of the before mentioned land to him the said Littleton R. Edwards his heirs and
 assigns forever and he the said William T. Blom doth for himself his heirs Executors
 administrators or assigns warrant, and will forever defend all right title claims and interests
 to the before mentioned property to him the said Littleton R. Edwards his heirs and assigns
 forever Upon the following Terms Viz. That if the said William T. Blom shall fail to
 pay and discharge the aforesaid debts with all costs pertaining to the same then the
 shall be lawful and right, so soon as requested in writing from under the hand of the
 said Henry Henry his heirs or assigns to sell up and sell to the highest bidder for
 Cash the aforesaid Tracts of land after giving notice by advertisement ten days previous
 to the day of sale, and out of the proceeds pay the debts and costs and the surplus
 of any sum over to the said William T. Blom his heirs or assigns. In Witness whereof
