That indenture made and entered into the 20th day of March 1832. Between Giles Reed of the County of Southampton of the first part, Edward Butts of the second part, and Henry Harris of the third part. Whereas the said Henry Harris stands bound for the said Giles Reed in a Bond executed to Richard Porter for the sum of thirty dollars twenty five cents payable on the 25th day of December 1830. is also bound in a bond executed to Richard Porter for the sum of thirty two dollars fifty cents payable on the 25th day of December 1830. is also bound in a Bond executed to John Drury for the sum of seventy dollars payable on the 25th day of December 1831. is also bound in a Bond executed to Charles Francis for the sum of One Hundred and nineteen dollars twenty nine cents. payable on the 16th day of September 1832. is also bound in a Bond executed to the said Charles Francis and Henry Lloyd for the sum of about forty seven dollars payable on the day of October 1832. is also bound in a Bond executed to B. Williams and William Jones for the sum of One Hundred and nine dollars payable on the 26th day of October 1832. is also bound in a Bond executed to Thomas P. Smith for the sum of fifty five dollars twenty five cents, payable on the 25th day of December 1831. is also bound in a Bond executed to George Goodwyn for the sum of Eight dollars payable on the 25th day of December 1831. is also bound in a Bond executed to the said George Goodwyn for the sum of twelve dollars payable on the 25th day of December 1832. is also bound in a Bond executed to Peter Bunker for the sum of fifty one dollar twenty five cents payable on the 25th day of December 1832. is also bound in a Bond executed to Thomas Porter for the sum of forty five dollars payable on the 25th day of October 1832. is also bound in a Bond executed to Henry Lloyd for the sum of thirty four dollars and ten cents payable on the 25th day of October 1832. is also indebted to the said Henry Harris Guardian to Jane Drury for the rent of the plantation wherein he now lives for four years tenet for years 1830. 1831. 1832. & 1833 at sixty four dollars for each year. And whereas the said Giles Reed is desirous effectually to secure and save himself from all loss or damage by reason of his security hereinafter specified:

That indenture therefore. Wherefore. Whereas. That as well for and in consideration of the premises as for the sum of one dollar to the said Giles Reed in hand paid by the said Edward Butts before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Giles Reed have given granted, bargained and sold, and by these do give grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said Edward Butts the following property to wit: four hundred twenty five head of cattle, thirty head of hogs, ten apoke of oxen, a number of deer, four head and furniture, chairs, Crookery ware, dishes, Chest of Drawers, Cupboard one set of lamp, two pair best wheels, and Cuts, Kitchen furniture plantation utensils, twenty^{two} head of black one negro woman Cherry, all the Crops of Corn Cotton and all other descriptions now sown or growing, as well as all future Crops which may be produced on the before mentioned land.

To have and to hold to him the said Edward Butts the property aforesaid to him the said Edward Butts has him and assigns forever upon Trust. Nevertheless that the said Giles Reed is to retain possession of all the said property until default be made in any of the aforesaid debts, then the said Edward Butts shall at any time after the happening of said default, at the request of the said Henry Harris after giving twenty days notice of his intention to the said Giles Reed at public auction the property herein mentioned for cash, and if the purchaser pay the expenses of this trust, the debt herein specified and interest and costs that may accrue and the balance if any pay to the said Giles Reed or his order, and that the said Giles Reed covenants that the said Edward Butts Trust as aforesaid shall have good title to the said conveyed property and possession thereof for the purposes hereof.

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
