This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of March 1832, between Giles Russ
of the County of Gloucester of the first part, Edward Butts of the second part, and Henry Harris of
the third part. Whereas the said Harry Harris stands bound for the said Giles Russ in a
Bond executed to Richard Porter for the sum of thirty Dollars twenty five cents payable on the
25th day of December 1830, is also bound in a bond executed to Richard Porter for the sum of
thirty two dollars fifty cents payable on the 25th day of December 1830, also bound in a
bond executed to John Drury for the sum of twenty dollars payable on the 25th day of January
1831, is also bound in a Bond executed to Captain Francis for the sum of One Thousand and
one hundred dollars Twenty nine cents payable on the 10th day of September 1832, is also bound in a
bond executed to the said Nathaniel Francis and Henry Harris for the sum of about
forty seven dollars payable on the day of October 1832, is also bound in a Bond executed
to W. Williamson and William Jones for the sum of One Hundred and one dollars paya-
ble on the 26th day of October 1832, is also bound in a Bond executed to Thomas P. Smith
for the sum of forty five dollars twenty five cents, payable on the 25th day of December 1832,
is also bound in a Bond executed to George Gordons for the sum of Eight Dollars payable
on the 25th day of December 1831, is also bound in a Bond executed to the said George Gordons
says for the sum of twelve dollars payable on the 25th day of December 1832, is also bound
in a Bond executed to Rives Barker for the sum of fifty one dollar twenty five cents, paya-
ble on the 25th day of December 1832, is also bound in a bond executed to Thomas Porter
for the sum of forty four dollars payable on the 25th day of October 1832, is also bound in a
bond executed to Henry Harris for the sum of thirty four dollars and ten cents payable on the 25th
1832, is also indebted to the said Harry Harris his Guardian to Jane Drury for the rent of the plantation
whereon he now lives for four years to wit for years 1830, 1831, 1832 & 1833 at forty five dollars
for each year. And whereas the said Giles Russ is desirous effectually to secure and defend
himself the said Harry Harris from all loss or damage by reason of his securityship aforesaid:

The said Harry Harris therefore doth hereby that as well for and in consideration of the premises
for the sum of One dollar to the said Giles Russ in handpaid by the said Edward Butts
before the sealing and delivery of this instrument the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
by the said Giles Russ have given granted, bargained and held, and by these depositions
Signed and Sealed and Conveyed unto the said Edward Butts the following property to wit four
horses twenty four head of cattle, thirty head of hogs two yoke of oxen, one and a half acres
bed and furniture, Chais, Crockery ware, desk, Chest of Drawers, Cupboard one egg & Game
two pair Cart wheels, and Carts, Kitchen furniture plantation utensils, twenty ^{one} head of Chick-
ens negro woman Cherry, all the Crops of Corn Cotton and all other description now wild
or growing, as well as all future Crops which may be produced on the before mentioned land.
To have and to hold to him the said Edward Butts the property aforesaid to him the said
Edward Butts his heirs and assigns forever. Upon Trust nevertheless that the said Giles
Russ is to retain possession of all the said property until default be made in any of the
afore said debt, then the said Edward Butts shall at any time after the happening of said
default, at the request of the said Harry Harris after giving twenty days notice of time and
place of sale at public Auction the property herein mentioned for cash, and of the
proceeds pay the expenses of this trust, the debts herein specified and costs that
may accrue and the balance if any pay to the said Giles Russ or his order, and the said
Giles Russ Promises that the said Edward Butts trustee as aforesaid shall have good
title to the said Conveyed property and keep and hold it for the purpose hereof.
