Witnesseth the said William D Clarke's interest in seven slaves held by the said Sally Pope and now
for his together with all his the said William D Clarke's interest, right and title inward
to a certain tract or parcel of land, with its appurtenances, devised to be sold by the last will
and testament of Joseph Pope & also all debts due the said William D Clarke by account or otherwise
To have and to hold the said real and personal property, with all and singular the
privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said James D Mapaunting his true
Executor ad m' and assigns forever. In trust nevertheless that if the said William D
Clarke has but £200 or more shall wear and truly pay the several sums of money herein
mentioned, with all the interest which may accrue thereon, and shall also pay all the
said other demands, with all the interest which may accrue thereon according to the said
William D Clarke's several undertakings in that respect: then this Indenture no thing
herein contained is to be void. But if the said William D Clarke shall make default and
fail to pay any sum of money or sum and amount aforesaid and the interest which may accrue thereon
or any part thereof then as soon as all or any one of the said demands, or any other person
claiming title by virtue hereof, shall, upon notice given writing the said James D Mapaunting
his Executor or administrator shall cause to sell the real and personal property hereby
conveyed, at public auction to the highest bidder, having previously fixed the time and place
of sale and given notice thereof for two weeks successively, at the courthouse door of Smith-
ington County at one or more public places in the said County and in one or more of the newspapers
published in the Borough of Norfolk, and apply so much of the purchase money as will
be sufficient to pay and satisfy whatever sum or sums of money as shall be then due for dues
and, recording this debt and all costs and charges attending the execution of this trust, and
then pay the debt and demands aforesaid in the following order, first the debt for which
the said Sally Pope, Alexander Myrick and William Lawrence are bound as aforesaid
shall be first paid and the residue of the said debt, or demands shall next be paid in equal
proportion: and whatever balance of money or residue of property shall remain, shall be retained
to the said William D Clarke or his proper representation: And it is covenanted and agreed
by and between the said William D Clarke and James D Mapaunting that no creditor of
the said William D Clarke is to be allowed or permitted to claim the benefit of this debt
or anything by virtue thereof, otherwise than upon the condition of releasing and discharging
him the said William D Clarke from all other and further responsibility for debt now due
and owing: And the said James D Mapaunting, for himself, his executors and administrators
covenants with the other parties to these presents that he will faithfully execute the trust hereby
reposed in him, and should a sale be made by virtue thereof, that he will faithfully
apply the proceeds of such sale according to the true intent and meaning of this indenture and that
no default be made that he will, when required by the said William D Clarke who his
legal representative, a clean and ready money to have the property aforesaid: and until
such date as is herein before mentioned shall be made, that the said William D Clarke
or his legal representative shall have the uninterrupted possession use and benefit
