acknowledged Have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the
said William Prince his heirs and assigns a certain piece of land containing fifteen acres
lying the land recently purchased by the said Mark T. Pate of Henry Rice and others
together with all rents profits privileges and emoluments and every part and parcel thereof
to have and to hold the said land with the tenements and all and singular rights thereto
promised unto the said William Prince his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mark
T. Pate the said tract of land unto the said William Prince his heirs and assigns free
from the claims or claims of him the said Mark T. Pate or his heirs and of all and every
person or persons whatsoever. Shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these

thirty one Between Jacob Williams of the County of Southampton of the one part and Laurence
Pope of the aforesaid County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Jacob Williams for and
in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and six dollars and seventy five Cents Current
money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Laurence Pope at a before the sealing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Jacob Williams doth hereby acknowl-
edge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Laurence Pope his heirs Executors and assigns
power and by these presents him the said Jacob Williams hath granted bargained sold
conveyed released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell convey
release and confirm unto the said Laurence Pope his heirs and assigns forever one plantation
parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton on the west
side of Ramon's road containing One hundred and one acres and half and bounded as follow
to wit Beginning at a Black oak standing in the head of the head pin branch a corner in
Joseph Rice's line thence along the said Branch to the Bridge Branch thence along the
Bridge Branch to the Pond Branch thence along the Pond Branch to a pine corner
the said Branch to a pine a new corner made for Jacob Williams and Mc Cajah Holloman
thence a straight line of marked trees to a post oak a corner standing in Joseph Rice's
line thence along the said line to the beginning containing one hundred and one
acres and half be the same more or less together with houses and houses edifices woods
meadows water courses water less ground profits Commodities hereditaments and appurtenances
