Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Prince the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant and deliver unto the  
said William Prince his heirs and assigns a certain piece of land containing fifteen acres  
of land recently purchased by the said Mark S. Peete of Elaney Rose and others  
together with all rents profits privileges and emoluments and every part and parcel thereof  
to have and to hold the said land with the tenements and all and singular whatsoever  
premises unto the said William Prince his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mark  
S. Peete the said tract of land unto the said William Prince his heirs and assigns free  
from the claims or claims of him the said Mark S. Peete or his heirs and of all and every  
person or persons whatsoever shall well and do warrant and forever defend by these  
presents In witness whereof the said Mark S. Peete have hereunto set his hand

This Indenture made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and  
thirty one Between Jacob Williams of the County of Southampton of the one part and Lawrence  
Pope of the aforesaid County of the other part witnesseth that the said Jacob Williams for and  
in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and six dollars and twenty five cents Current  
money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Lawrence Pope at or before the sealing  
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Jacob Williams doth hereby acknowl-  
edge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Lawrence Pope his heirs Executors and ad-  
ministrators and by these presents him the said Jacob Williams hath granted bargained and sold  
devised released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant Bargain sell alien  
and Convey unto the said Lawrence Pope his heirs and assigns forever One plantation  
parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton on the west  
side of Bass's road Containing One hundred and One acres and half and bounded as follow-  
ing Beginning at a Black oak standing in the head of the horse pen branch a corner in  
Joseph Reed's line thence along the said Branch to the Bridge Branch thence along the  
Bridge Branch to the Pond Branch thence along the Pond Branch to a pine tree across  
the said Branch to a pine a new corner made for Jacob Williams and his wife Adeline  
thence a straight line of marked trees to a post set a corner standing in Joseph Reed's  
line thence along the said line to the beginning Containing one hundred and one  
acres and half be the same more or less together with houses and houses Edifices and  
buildings water courses water lots ground for its Commodities husbandments and appurtenances  
whatsoever and necessary and convenient therefor and remainsder rents, issues and profits thereon
