Hath bargained and sold And by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said William E Lawrence his heirs and assigns One certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation Eighty seven and a half acres more or less bounded by the land belonging to Jesse Gardner William Mills Matthew Vaughan and Henry Vaughan's estate & conveyed from the said William E Lawrence (as Trustee) to the said Avert Edwards by Deed bearing date the 1st day of January 1831. together with the revenues and revenues & revenues and remainder yearly and also rents issues and profits and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights member and appurtenances unto the said William E Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever.
