 One between John Rawlings of the one part and David Prince of the other part: both of the County
 of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said John Rawlings for and in
 Consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars lawful money of Virginia to him
 paid or otherwise to be paid by the said David Prince at or before the making and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
 sold and conveyned and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
 David Prince his heirs and assigns, a certain tract price a parcel of land situate lying and
 being in the County of Southampton Containing One hundred acres be the same more or
 less bounded as follows viz Beginning at a poplar a corner David Prince and Elizabeth
 Gizzard thence up the run of the branch to a black gum a corner on said Gizzard thence
 up a little branch to a black gum a corner on Benjamin Lewis thence a straight line to
 scrub oak on said Lewis thence a straight line to a pine a corner on said Lewis thence
 straight line to a poplar a corner on said Lewis thence up the branch to the beginning together
 with all and singular appurtenances and premises and the reversion and remainder
 remainders and remainders, yearly and other rents ifees and profits thereof and of every
 part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the
