This Indenture made this 5th day of January in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand Eight hundred and thirty two Between Barton Daniel of the first part and Patrick Dole of the second part Witnesseth that the said Barton Daniel in Consideration of the sum of five dollars of lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Patrick Dole before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Patrick Dole his heirs and assigns one certain acre of land be the same more or less where the grave yard is and the said Acre of land is to include the said grave yard and Commencing at a Sycamore at the East Corner of the said Grave yard and then a line of marked Cedars a West Corner to another Sycamore a Corner tree then down a line of marked Cedars a North Corner to another Sycamore a Corner tree and then a line of marked Cedars a East Corner to the fourth Sycamore a Corner tree then on a line of marked Cedars to the East Corner to the Sycamore where we first started which trees are all to be planted hereafter To have and to hold the said Acre of land be the same more or less unto the said Patrick Dole his heirs and assigns forever he and for the only proper use and behoof of and him the said Barton Daniel for himself his heirs the said Land before mentioned unto the said Patrick Dole his heirs and assigns free from the Claim of him the said Barton Daniel his heirs and of all and every other person or persons who at now or shall will and do claim and demand and for ever defend by these presents.
