 of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid at and by the
 making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 this day given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give and convey
 and sell unto the said John Adams and his heirs forever One certain tract or parcel
 of Land together with all houses and houses and appurtenances thereunto attached or in any
 way belonging lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by recent survey
 Minety One acres to the said man or less And bounded by the lands of Benjamin Abbott
 George Ivory William P. Evans and John Rockhamdr^d unto him the said John Adams
 his heirs and assigns for they the said James Harris and his wife Sarah M do warrant
 and forever defend the right title and interest to said tract or parcel of Land and all
 the improvements of every description against the claim and demand of him the said John
 and Sarah his wife their and each of them or either of them and against the claim and
