 of the same County of the other part. Witnesseth That the said James Harrison and his wife
 Sarah M. have this day for and in consideration of the premises and for the further considera-
 tion of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid at and by the
 inselving and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and
 this day given granted bargained and sold and by these presents conveying and conveyed
 and sell unto the said John Thomas and his heirs forever. One Certain tract or parcel
 of Land together with all houses and houses and appurtenances thereto attached or in any
 way belonging lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by recent survey
 nearly One Acre to the land more or less and bounded by the Lands of Benjamin & Elizabeth
 George Bry William P. Condit and John Bonham are? unto him the said John Thomas
 his heirs and assigns for they the said James Harrison and his wife Sarah M. do warrant
 and for ever defend the right title and interest to said tract or parcel of Land and all
 the improvements of every description against the claim and demand of whom the said James
 and Sarah his wife their and each of their or either of their heirs and against the claim and
