This Indenture made the 13th day of January in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty two Between Miller Hedgforth the debtor of the first part, Patrick Rose the Trustee of the second part and Jason Rose the Creditor of the third part. Whereas the said Miller Hedgforth is justly indebted to the said Jason Rose the sum of Sixty Eight dollars and 70 cents to be paid on the 13th day of November in the year 1832. as by a bond bearing date on the 12th day of January in the year 1832. which bond fully appears which debt with the legal interest thereon securing the said Miller Hedgforth is owing and due to secure aforesaid Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Miller Hedgforth the debt so in hand paid by the said Patrick Rose the trustee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. As the said Miller Hedgforth has given granted bargained sold alured entreated and confirmed unto the said Jason Rose his heirs and assigns forever all that one horse and one son and six shotts and one saddle bed and furniture also his part of his Crop which he may make this present year to have and to hold the said horse granted or intended to be hereby granted property also one son and six shotts and one bed and furniture and also the part of his Crop which he may make this present year unto the said Patrick Rose his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever to the use of his heirs and executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Miller Hedgforth for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Patrick Rose his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever in manner and form following that is to say that the said Miller Hedgforth his heirs executors among the aforesaid named property to him one horse one son and six shotts and one bed and furniture also his Crop or his part of the Crop for the present year unto the said Patrick Rose his heirs executors administrators and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. Upon Trustt. Nevertheless that the said Patrick Rose his heirs executors administrators shall permit the said Miller Hedgforth to remain quiet and peaceable proprietor of the said property namely One horse one son and six shotts and one bed and furniture also his Crop which the said Miller Hedgforth may make and take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said sum of Sixty Eight dollars and Twenty three Cents either in the whole or in part. and then upon this further trustt. that they or any two or either of them or the survivor of them or the heirs executors administrators or assigns of such survivor shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of payment as they or any or either of them or the survivor of them or the heirs executors administrators or assigns of such survivor may think proper or the said Patrick Rose his heirs executors administrators or assigns shall request sell the said property namely One horse one son and six shotts One featherbed and furniture also the part of the Crop that the said Miller Hedgforth makes or such part of the hereby granted property as the Trustee or their representatives hereby authorized to sell shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think proper to sell to the highest bidder for ready money at public auction after having fixed the time and place of sale at their own discretion and giving ten days notice turned in one or more of the newspapers and also通知 the same by advertisement to be set up at the County house of Southampton County On some County day for years to come day of sale and out of the money arising from such sale shall after satisfying the charges
