This Indenture made and entered into this 22^d day of January 1832 between Lewis Fells of Lincoln
County and State of Virginia of the first part, Cuthbert D. Bingham of the second part, and Benjamin
Edwards of the third part: Whereas the said Benjamin Edwards is security for Lewis Fells to a
Bond of twenty dollars due some time in August 1832 and the said Fells being desirous to insure
the said Edwards against any loss which he may sustain in the security thereof promising
truth granted bargained and sold (as well as for the promises above mentioned as of the one idea) of the
sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Cuthbert D. Bingham before the signing and
delivery of these presents to the said Cuthbert D. Bingham his Executor &c. the following property to wit
two beds and furniture two pine chests, one Cupboard 2 bar chairs and one pine table one Corn
parcel of 500 lbs. of tea, sardines 10 and hamper and for the kitchen furniture &c. To have and to
hold to his proper use and behoof for ever upon trust nevertheless that the said Bingham shall
permit the said Fells to remain in quiet possession of the above mentioned property and take
the profits thereof to his own proper use until the 1st day of July 1832 at the time the
said Bond is ordered, and at which time if the said Edwards shall request, the said
Bingham after giving reasonable notice of the time and place of sale, expose to sale the said
property, or as much thereof as will be sufficient for the purpose and out of the proceeds of the
said sale first pay the Costs and expenses thereof, then pay and satisfy the debt aforesaid
for which the said Edwards is said Fells security or so much thereof as may be due at the
time and the balance if any, pay over to the said Fells or his legal representatives and the said
Fells covenants with said ^{Bingham} Edwards that he is possessed of an absolute estate of fee simple in the
property above conveyed, and that he will never warrant, and defend the same against himself
and every other person whatsoever In Testimony whereof the said several parties have
