This Indenture made this 18th day of February one thousand Eight hundred and
Thirty four between Saml. Bacham George L. Bacham and Soloman D. Parker
Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to make sale of the Land
whereof Edward Butts did sayd and proposed, of the County aforesaid and State of
Virginia of the One part, and Bacham & Co: of the aforesaid Court and State of the
other part. witness that witness the said Commissioners for and in consideration of
the sum of Four hundred, and five dollars to them in hand paid by the said John
Worms, the receipt whereof they hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and
sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Worms the
tract of Land aforesaid Containing by late Survey One hundred, and forty four and
half acres, to the same more or less and bounded as follows: Beginning at a white
oak near the run of the Raccoon Swamp in B. Worms' line thence along
line of marked trees northwardly to a Dogwood tree a corner of Joseph Bonner's land
thence along a line of marked trees to a black or portor tree in George Blon's line then
westwardly to the old Road thence southwardly down said road to a cherry tree
a strait line to the swamp aforesaid thence down the said swamp to the beginning
of John's and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land, with all and singular the
appurtenances thereto belonging to the only propriece and benefit of him the said Worms
his Executors administrators and assigns "W" also Pleasant, the title to the said Land
