This Indenture made this 18th day of February one thousand Eight hundred and thirty two Between Saml. Basham George A. C. Basham and Solomon D. Parker Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to make sale of the Land whereof Edwms. Watts died seized and possessed, of the County aforesaid and State of Virginia of the One part, and Basham, Worren of the aforesaid County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Commissioners for and in consideration of the Sum of Four hundred and five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Basham Worren, the receipt whereof they hereby acknowledge, have granted bargain and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Worren the tract of Land aforesaid containing by late Survey One hundred and thirty four and half acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows Beginning at a white oak near the run of the Nassau Swamp in B. Worren's line thence along the line of marked trees northwardly to a Dogwood tree a Corner of Joseph Brown's line thence along a line of marked trees to a black or sweet Gum in George Blon's line thence Westwardly to the Old Road thence Southwardly down said road to a Cherry tree in a straight line to the swamp aforesaid thence down the said Swamp to the Beginning To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land, with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Worren his Executors administrators and assigns We also declare that both the said Land and is vested in us as Commissioners.
