Mrs Indenture made this 3^d day of January with the Seal of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred and thirty two Between Saml. Drury and George Ege, acting Commissioners
 appointed by the County Court of Southampton of the said County and State of Virginia of
 the one part, and Joseph E. Claude of the said County and State of the other part. Witness
 us that for and in Consideration of the Sum of money hereinafter the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged by the said Commissioners which granted bargained and by these two
 parties do grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Joseph E. Claude and his heirs
 forever a certain tract or parcel of Land, which John Holt did survey and propose
 with containing ninety four acres it to be the same more or less situated in the County
 of Southampton and bounded on the South by the lands of said John Holt's Estate on
 the West by the lands of Elizabeth Ege on the North and east by the Land belonging
 to the estate of John Barham dec'd and which will appear more fully to say the
 said Land was purchased by the said Holt after making his last Will and Testament
 from Commissioners which Land belonged to the estate of Carter Mutchings. To have
 and to hold the same with all the improvements and benefits thereto belonging unto
 the said Claude, his heirs and assigns forever, which said Land was the said Drury
 and Ege acting as Commissioners do warrant and forever defend the title of said Land
 unto the said Claude and his heirs forever against the claims or demands of every person
