I Will Indenture make this 16th day of January One thousand Eight hundred and thirty two
 Between Ernest Drake of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part
 Benjamin Williams of the said County and State of the second part, and Henry Joyner
 of the aforesaid County and State of the third part, Will Intercipre that whereas the said
 Ernest Drake stands indebted by Bond to the said Benjamin Williams in the sum of my
 three dollars And whereas for the further assurance of the payment it is agreed by the parties
 hereto that a money answer shall be made to the said Henry Joyner for the benefit
 of the said Benj Williams in case the said Bond shall not be punctually paid and before
 interest thereon due or before the ninth day of August One thousand Eight hundred and thirty two
 Now this Indenture Will Intercipre that the said Ernest Drake for and in Consideration
 of the promises and for the further sum of one dollar in hand paid to him the receipt whereof
 is acknowledged has bargained sold and by these presents doth for himself his heirs
 Execut and administrators give grant bargaine and sell unto the said Henry Joyner his heirs
 assigns one bay mare one pony all and herfys and one foal he bed defuncte being
 in the County of Southampton aforesaid To have and to hold the above granted and his
 property unto the said Henry Joyner his heirs and assigns in trust forever And to
 hereby declare to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that if the said Ernest
 Drake shall punctually pay to the said Benjamin Williams his heirs or assigns the
 sum of thirty three dollars and interest agreeable to the time of the bond above granted to
 the said Benj Williams then the said Henry Joyner his heirs and assigns shall hold
 the said bond &c above granted to the use and benefit of the said Ernest Drake
 And the said Henry Joyner covenants and agrees with the parties hereto that in
 case the said Ernest Drake his Executors and administrators shall fail to make payment
 to the said Benj Williams his heirs and assigns on or before the 9th day of August
 next the whole sum due on the bond aforesaid then the said Henry Joyner his heirs
 and assigns shall stand bound of the above granted and bargained property for the payment
