Witnesseth that the said James Bryant and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty four dollars Current money of this Commonwealth then in hand paid by the said Lewis Morrell at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have granted conveyed sold aliened Enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents do and each of them do acknowledge full right title interest claim or demand of or to or contain in divided land or parcel of Land of which Dancy Bryant father of said James Bryant died seized and possessed them by the name of the Hurst plantation Situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St Lukes containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of said Lewis Morrell William Bryant and others Together with all right title interest claim or demand of or to their proper title part of the aforesaid land or parcel of undivided Land and premises with its appurtenances
