This Indenture made this 10th day of February in the year of our Lord 1832 Between Daniel Williams and Mary Ann Williams his wife of the first part Jesse Lankford of the second part and Reas Rivers of the third part Whereas the said Daniel Williams and Mary Ann Williams his wife are jointly indebted to the said Reas Rivers in the sum of Three hundred and Eighty five dollars to be paid on the tenth day of June next in the present year as by a Bond bearing date with these promises manifestly appears which debt the said Daniel Williams and Mary Ann his wife are willing and desirous to secure Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar to the said Daniel Williams and Mary Ann his wife in hand paid by the said Jesse Lankford at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Daniel Williams and Mary Ann his wife have given granted bargained sold aliened conveyed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien convey release and confirm to the said Jesse Lankford his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia containing three hundred and Eighty three acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a white oak stand in or the side of the Cypress swamp at Corner of Amos Connells Land thence along George Williams line to Elizabeth Williams line thence along her land to Court Duncans line thence along said Duncans line to the Cypress swamp and to Jesse Lankfords line thence along said Lankfords line to Reas Rivers line thence along said Rivers line to Edwin Clay's line to the Cypress swamp and up the said Cypress swamp to the
