This Indenture made this 7th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred and thirty two Between William A. Jones Lewis Harris and Benjamin Williams
 the acting Commissioners appointed by a Decree of the County Court of Southampton bearing date
 November 1831 to make sale of a certain tract or parcel of Land belonging to the Estate
 of John Parham dec^d called the Murrell plantation of the one part, and Joseph F. Clanton
 of the said County and state of the other part, Witnesses that the said William A. Jones
 Lewis Harris and Benjamin Williams Commissioners aforesaid for and in consideration of the
 sum of four hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Joseph F. Clanton
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and hath granted bargained and sold and by these
 presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph F. Clanton his heirs and assigns
 a certain tract or parcel of Land which the said John Parham did seize and possess
 called Murrell lying and being in the County and state aforesaid and on the south side of
 the three tracts containingly an old survey Three hundred and fourteen acres and adjoining
 the Lands of Polly Thorpe John A. Thomas William A. Jones and others be the same
 more or less To have and to hold the said bargain and sold Land together with its
 appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the only proper use and
 behoof of him the said Joseph F. Clanton his heirs and assigns forever and the said William
 A. Jones Lewis Harris and Benjamin Williams Commissioners aforesaid do for them do as their
 heirs Executors and assigns warrant and defend the rights and title of said Land against all
 and every other person or persons who shall or will In Witness whereof the said William A. Jones
 Lewis Harris and Benjamin Williams Commissioners aforesaid have hereunto
 set their hands and seals the day and date first above written
