West at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Sefo S. West his heirs and assigns two certain tracts or parcels of Land lying and be within aforesaid County and State One tract containing twenty six acres lying south of the flat swamp bounded by the Lands of Aaron at or left dec^d Thomas James and Sefo S. West and one other tract north of the flat swamp containing thirty six acres and bounded by the Lands of William Francis making in all sixty acres be the same more or less to have the said Sefo S. West with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said lands or any part thereof To have and to hold the said tracts or parcels of Land to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Sefo S. West his heirs and assigns forever and the said John R. Williams do for myself my heirs and assigns by the said tracts or parcels of Land with all and singular the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Sefo S. West his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said John R. Williams his heirs &c. and of all and every person or persons whatever shall ever or do so want and forever defend by these presents In W.
