This Indenture made this first day of October in the year of our Lord 1828 between Thomas B.
 Worrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Worrell of the same County
 and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas B. Worrell for and in consideration of the sum
 of One thousand Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Worrell at or before the making of
 & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Each grantee hereinafter
 sold and by these presents doth go with bargain and sell along with off and confirm unto him the
 said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying
 and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Lukes containing by
 Estimation One hundred and twenty acres be the same more or less it being a part of the Lands whereon
 Jacob Bailey dec^d formerly resided lying on the South side of the road leading from Hicks Church to
 Monro and bounded as follows to wit Beginning in the Run of the Arthur Swamp where the
 Road crosses it in Jordan's line thence down the Run of said Swamp the Run in corner thence
 to a corner for said Lewis Worrell's Grounds and then in Hicks line thence along the said Lewis Worrell's
 line of marked trees to the aforesaid road a new corner made in said Lewis Worrell's line thence along
 said Road Westwardly thence to the first station together with all right title interest claim or
 demand of and to the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with all houses outbuildings
 ways waters and water courses thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold
 the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises as above described unto him the said Lewis
 Worrell his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said
 Lewis Worrell and his heirs forever And the said Thomas B. Worrell for himself his heirs Executors
 administrators and assigns doth covenant and agree to and with the said Lewis Worrell
 his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and defend
 the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part or parcel
 thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever In Witness
 whereof the said Thomas B. Worrell have hereto set my hands and affixed my seal
